Burton Community Council is seeking views to help us review the future options for Barnlake Wood ...




The footpath is overgrown ^[1] and in places impassible. We have asked Pembrokeshire County Council [who took over the Freehold from Barnlake Engineering in 1985] to clear the right of way. The fence ^[2] also needs maintaining. It is often tranquil at the waters edge ^[3] but the bench ^[4] is very rotten..

- Do we set up a local support group?
